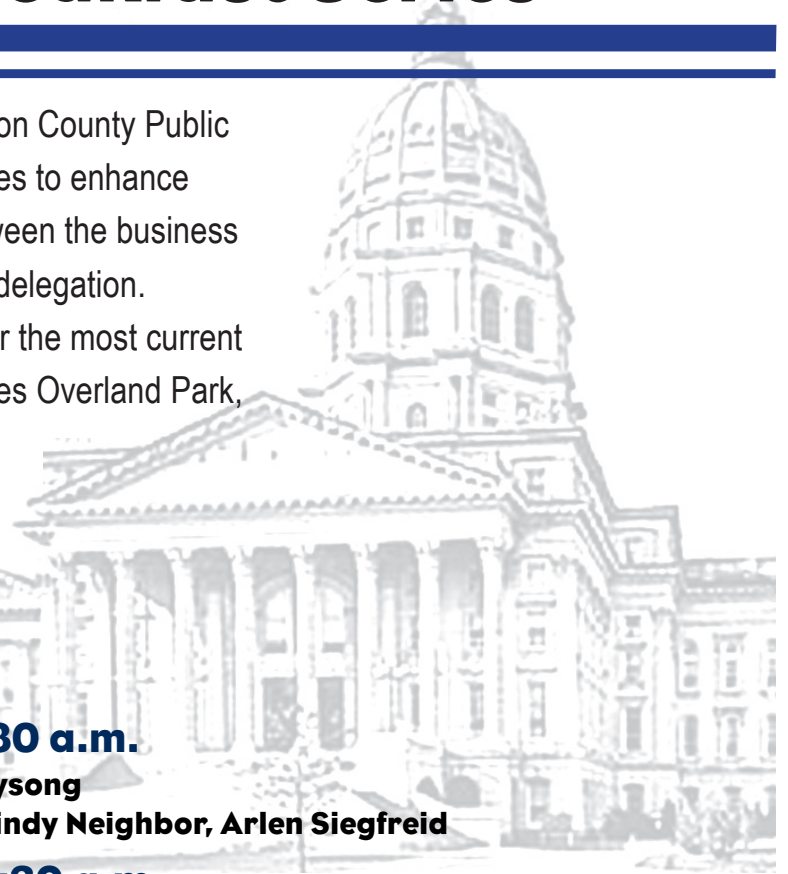


2008 Legislative Breakfast Series
